- 1. Calves, 4-H'ers, and chaperones to arrive at the Woodstock Fairgrounds on Thursday, July 11th between 10 a.m. and noon
- 2. Calf must be the 2024 calf project of the 4-H member. Substitutes allowed if calf is sick. Participant may use another calf from home or a calf from the show **only** for showmanship.
- 3. CALVES MUST BE CLIPPED EXCEPT FOR THE TOPLINE PRIOR TO ARRIVAL. The organizing committee will have fitters available to assist the contestants to complete the topline of the calf but participants should supply their own topline materials (eq Got2B spray, paint)
- 4. All calves must be dual tagged (button and panel) with dairy approved tags.
- 5. Stall cards will be provided to identify the calf and 4-H member.
- 6. Full Whites and appropriate footwear are required for showmanship and conformation classes T-shirts will be provided for participants.
- 7. Harness number cards will be used (bring your own harnesses).
- 8. Health, Medical and Participant agreements are now part of your online registration.
- 9. All leaders, chaperones, parents, and volunteers must abide by Ontario 4-H Council Board Policies, which can be viewed at https://4-hontario.ca/about-4-h/policies/.
