This show is open to all dairy calf club members 9-13 years of age, as of January 1, 2024, who are registered as 4-H members in the counties of West-Central Ontario Holstein District. This show is designed as an educational and fun event. This year we will be awarding the **Sally Medwell Memorial Award** to the participant that demonstrates teamwork, cooperation, leadership and overall good sportsmanship.

- 1. Calves, 4-H'ers and chaperones to arrive at the Elora Fairgrounds and Raceway between noon and 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 22nd. **No calves in the barn before vet inspection. Participants can come in to make the pack.**
- 2. Calves must be the 2024 calf project of the 4-H member.
- 3. CALVES **MUST BE CLIPPED** EXCEPT FOR THE TOPLINE PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AT THE FAIRGROUNDS. The organizing committee will have fitters available to assist the contestants to complete the topline of the calf.
- 4. Stall cards will be provided to identify the calf and 4-H member.
- 5. All calves must be dual tagged (button and panel) with approved dairy tags.
- 6. County tie ups will be assigned to encourage group environment. Participants are required to bring their own straw. No shavings will be allowed.
- 7. Health, Medical and Participant agreements are now part of your online registration.
- 8. Calves will be inspected for ringworm and warts. Please be proactive and leave calves with health concerns at home. Participant may use another calf from home for showmanship and conformation **or** a calf from the show **only** for showmanship.
- 9. Harness cards will be used Bring your own show harnesses to the show.
- 10. All leaders, chaperones, parents, and volunteers must abide by Ontario 4-H Council Board Policies, which can be viewed at https://4-hontario.ca/about-4-h/policies/
